### **Atlanta Happenings Cultural Enthusiasts**

- Visit the Atlanta Civic Center between Jan. 23-June 13 to see the international exhibition, [Diana: A Celebration](#), before it returns to England. The exhibition chronicles the life of the late Diana, Princess of Wales, through nine galleries containing over 150 objects-ranging from her royal wedding gown and 28 of her designer dresses to family heirlooms, paintings, rare home movies and photos.
- [The Atlanta Dogwood Festival](#) (April 16-18) and The City of [Atlanta Jazz Festival](#) (May 28-30) return to Piedmont Park in 2010. Check out the [full lineup](#) of the city's great spring festivals on Atlanta.net.
- See 18 of the world's rarest and most brilliantly conceived cars from the 1930's to the mid-1960's at the High Museum of Art's [The Allure of the Automobile](#) exhibition (March 21-June 20).

- [The Atlanta Beat](#), kicking off in April, will be the ninth team in the Women's Professional Soccer league. Also, don't miss running in the [ING Georgia Marathon](#) on March 21, cheering on the [Atlanta Hawks](#) (through April 14) or catching an [Atlanta Braves](#) game (2010 season begins April 5).

### **Nature Lovers**

- In May, [Atlanta Botanical Garden](#) will open Canopy Walk, a 600-foot-long, 45-foot-high "skywalk" through the treetops of Storza Woods, one of the last remaining urban forests in Atlanta and home to stunning hardwoods.

### **Adventure Seekers**

- In May, [Six Flags Whitewater](#) will open Wiggles Water World, an interactive water playground based on the world's number one preschool entertainers - The Wiggles. Wiggles Water World will boast five interactive sections including The S.S. Feathersword, a 25-foot tall play ship.
- Through September 2010, the [Georgia Aquarium](#) will host [Planet Shark: Predator or Prey](#).
- In April, look out for [Atlanta's Most Valuable Package](#), which includes admission to five top attractions for one low price!

### **Foodies**

- At [30 Tables](#), located inside The Glenn Hotel in Downtown, fresh herbs are snipped from the 11 Stories rooftop garden. Old Fourth Ward's [4<sup>th</sup> & Swift](#) is home to an organic vegetable and herb garden on the patio and [Rosebud](#) captures the flavors of its neighbor, [Morningside Farmers Market](#), by featuring local and regional ingredients.
- Every Saturday morning, Atlanta's top chefs offer chef demos at Morningside Farmers Market and also at [The Green Market at Piedmont Park](#).
- Linked to Piedmont Park is the [Atlanta Botanical Garden](#) which will open an edible garden this spring. In addition to being filled with vegetables from around the world, aromatic herbs and edible flowers, the edible garden will feature an outdoor cooking demonstration kitchen and amphitheater where gourmet chefs will provide classes and tips on using delicious, healthful harvests.
